
Sub : Equivalency of foreign nursing qualification of foreign/ Indian candidates before admission in Post Basic B.Sc.(N) & M.Sc.(N) programmes in India - regarding -

Sir/Madam,

Please refer to the subject given above. It is to inform you that foreign/Indian candidates who have qualified their basic nursing qualification (GNM/B.Sc.(N)) from any foreign country and want to take admission to undergo P.B.B.Sc.(N) and M.Sc.(N) programme in India need to take approval of the Indian Nursing Council before admission to these courses even if they got the permission from the respective University. The foreign/ Indian nationals can be admitted in above programmes only when their basic foreign nursing qualification (GNM/B.Sc.(N)) is found equivalent to the nursing courses as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council.

It is therefore, such candidates may be advised to apply to the Indian Nursing Council for equivalency of their foreign nursing qualification (GNM/B.Sc.(N)) before admission in P.B.B.Sc.(N) and M.Sc.(N) programme to avoid any inconvenience.
