## **1. Submission/ opening of tenders: -**

- 1.1. The bids should be submitted in **sealed envelope** containing two sealed envelope i.e. Technical & Commercial Bid separately. Please super scribe the tender number. The name and address of the Bidder should clearly appear on the envelopes. Failure to do so will render your offer invalid.
- 1.2. Sealed quotations addressed to Joint Secretary, Indian Nursing Council, Combined Councils Building, Kotla Road, Temple Lane, New Delhi -110002 may be submitted at Indian Nursing Council Office. Alternatively, the tender may be sent by registered post by due date and time. No responsibility will be taken for postal delay or non-delivery/non-receipt of tender documents.
- 1.3. Sealed quotations will be opened by a Committee on due date and time. Your representative from the company can attend the tender opening. If due to any exigency, the due date for opening of tender is declared close holiday, in such case the tenders will be opened on next working day at the same time or any other day/time as intimated by the buyer.
- 1.4. Tenders sent by fax will not be considered. To avoid any complication with regard to late receipt/non-receipt of tenders, it may please be noted that responsibility rests with the tenderer to ensure that tenders reach before due date and time. Late quotes will be rejected out rightly.
- 1.5. In case, your firm is not willing to quote due to any reasons, your regret should be faxed well before the due date, failing which your firm can be de-listed from vendors list.

## **2. Experience:**

The bidder must have executed similar work in any Government office/ PSU and other similar organization during last three years. Necessary documents to this effect must be enclosed along with the offer.

## **3. Financial Status:**

The firm in this regard should submit the following documents -

- (a) Income Tax clearance/IT certificate
- (b) PAN Number
- (c) Sales tax registration certificate
- (d) TIN number of the firm
- (e) Telephone number (landline & mobile)

#### **4. Modification and withdrawal of bids:**

A withdrawal notice may be sent by fax but followed by a signed confirmation copy by post not later than the dead line for submission of bids. No bid shall be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and expiration of the period of bid validity specified. Withdrawal of a bid during the period will result in bidders for feature of bid security.

#### **5. Delivery:**

5.1 Supply and installation of the items should be made within 45 days from the date of the purchase/work order.

5.2 The contract is liable to be cancelled unilaterally if the supply/ installation is not completed within the specified time. Extension of contracted delivery period will be at the sole discretion of the buyer with applicability of liquidated damages clause.

#### **6. Liquidated damages:**

0.5% per week subject to a maximum of 5% of the undelivered stocks will be recovered in case of delay in delivery beyond the accepted delivery period as per general conditions of contract. Extension in delivery period shall not be granted for more then 10 weeks.

#### **7. Scope of Supply:**

The scope will cover supply, fixing, fitting, finishing and installation etc. of said items. The bidders may inspect the installation site after taking prior appointment on any working day.

#### **8. Earnest Money Deposit:**

The bidders will be required to furnish bid security (EMD) of Rs. 100,000/- (Rs. One Lac Only) in the form of Bank draft from any nationalized bank drawn in favour of Secretary, Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, The bid shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids. Offer not accompanied with earnest money of the requisite amount or without proper validity will be summarily rejected.

#### **9. Validity of Offer:**

The tenderer must keep their offer open for acceptance for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of opening of tender.

## **10. Acceptance of Offers:**

Order will be placed after the tender has been, as considered necessary, have been completed. The purchaser may accept the tender for a part or whole of the quantity offered or reject the same without assigning any reason.

## **11. Price:**

The price quoted by the bidder shall be firm and not subject to variation on any account during the fulfillment of the order. The price quoted shall be inclusive of packing, forwarding, freight charges, transit insurance and other charges as applicable. The price quoted shall also be including all taxes and duties e.g. Excise Duty, CST, and VAT etc. and any other Govt. levy as applicable, cartage, labour and nothing shall be paid extra on this account.

## **12. Terms of Payment:**

100% payment of the cost will be paid on satisfactory supply & installation of works after inspection. Bill in this regard duly supported with the inspection by the above document should be submitted to the Paying Authority and particulars of dispatch advised to the consignee.

## **13. Facilities for Test & Examination:**

If the material supplied by the manufacture/ supplier or performance of the material and/ or stores during inspection and tests is not found satisfactory, the Purchaser reserves the right at his discretion and without any claim for compensation to the Contractor, either cancel the order altogether or modify the quantity ordered.

## **14. Training:**

The successful bidder would provide adequate training for operation of the supplied items.

## **15. WARRANTY FOR PRODUCT PERFORMANCE:**

15.1. The successful bidder shall warrant that everything to be supplied hereunder shall be free from all defects and faults in material, workmanship and manufacture and shall be of the highest grade and consistent with the established and generally accepted standards for material of the type ordered and in full conformity with the contract specification, drawings or samples, if any, if operated properly.

15.2. Items shall be under minimum warranty for a period of **as mentioned in the requisite annexure** from the date of successful installation.

The contractor shall replace any defective goods/stores free of any charges or the repair of defective goods/stores within the warranty period.

- 15.3. The Contractor shall, if required replace or repair the goods or such portion thereof as is rejected by the Purchaser free of cost at the ultimate destination or at the option of Purchaser, the Contractor shall pay to the Purchaser value thereof at the contract price or in the absence of such price at price decided by the Purchaser and such other expenditure and damages as may arise by reason of the breach of the condition herein specified.
- 15.4. All replacement and repairs that the Purchaser shall call upon the Contractor to deliver or perform under this warranty shall be delivered and performed by the Contractor within one month promptly and satisfactorily. If the Contractor so desires, the replaced parts can be taken over by him or his representative for disposal as he deems fit at the time of replacement of goods/parts. No claim whatsoever shall lie on the Purchaser for the replaced parts thereafter.
- 15.5. The decision of the Purchaser in regard to Contractor's liability and the amount if any, payable under this warranty shall be final and conclusive.

**16. Performance Bank Guarantee for satisfactory supply/installation:**

- 16.1. The successful bidder shall have to submit a Performance Bank Guarantee as per for an amount of 10% of the total value of the contract in the name of Secretary, Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi. The Performance Bank Guarantee shall remain valid during the period of warranty for one year, after which the Performance Guarantee will be returned to the Contractor without any interest.
- 16.2. Bid security will be refunded to the successful bidder on receipt of Performance Bank Guarantee.
- 16.3. If the contractor fails to supply the materials to the satisfaction of the Purchaser or fails to comply with any terms and conditions of this bid offer, the Performance Bank Guarantee shall be encashed by the Purchaser.

**17. Evaluation Period:**

The broad guidelines for evaluation of offer will be as follows:

- 17.1. Only those offers shall be evaluated which are found to be fulfilling all the eligibility and qualifying requirement of the tender 1<sup>st</sup> **technically** and 2<sup>nd</sup> **commercially**.
- 17.2. Indian Nursing Council shall evaluate the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made,

whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are generally in order.

- 17.3. Arithmetical errors shall be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price will prevail and the total price shall be corrected by the Indian Nursing Council. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail. If the supplier does not accept the correction of errors, his bid shall be rejected.
  - 17.4. Prior to detailed evaluation, Indian Nursing Council will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the bid document. A substantially responsive bid is one which confirms to all the terms and conditions of the bid documents without material deviation. Indian Nursing Council determination of bids responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.
  - 17.5. A bid determined as substantially non responsive will be rejected by the Indian Nursing Council and shall not subsequent to the bid opening be made responsive by the bidder by correction of the non conformity.
  - 17.6. The lowest acceptable tender shall be considered further for placement of contract/supply order after complete clarification and price negotiations as applicable.
18. If the progress of manufacture and supply or performance of the material and/or stores during inspection and tests is not found satisfactory, the Purchaser reserves the right at his discretion and without any claim for compensation to the Contractor, either cancel the order altogether or modify the quantity ordered.
