Professional Education & Experience required for various posts in Nursing profession. Approved by the Indian Nursing Council in its meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> March, 1985.

### **1. HOSPITAL**

<u>Designation</u>	<u>Academic qualifications &amp; experience</u>
1. Staff nurse:	<p><u>Essential Qualification:</u> - Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife or B. Sc. (Nursing).</p> <p>N.B.:- Candidate holding B.Sc. Nursing be given 2 special increments.</p>
2. Ward Sister/Ward Supervisor/ Clinical Instructor.	<p><u>Essential qualifications:-</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife.</li><li>2. Diploma in Nursing Education and Administration/B.Sc./Post-Basic B.Sc. Nursing.</li><li>3. Five years experience as a Staff Nurse for the post of ward Sister.</li></ol> <p>N. B.:- B.Sc. Nurses can be directly recruited to the post of Clinical Instructor.</p>
3. Departmental Sisters/ Assistant Nursing Superintendent.	<p><u>Essential qualification:-</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife.</li><li>2. Diploma in Nursing Education and Administration/B.Sc. or Post-Basic Degree in Nursing.</li></ol> <p><u>Desirable:</u> - Experience as a Ward Sister for 5 years.</p>
4. Deputy Nursing Superintendent.	<p><u>Essential qualification:-</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Registered Nurses and Registered Midwife.</li><li>2. Diploma in Nursing Education and Administration/B.Sc. or Post-Basic Degree in Nursing.</li><li>3. Five years experience as Assistant Nursing Superintendent.</li></ol>

5. Nursing Superintendent.

Essential qualifications:-

1. Master degree in Nursing.
2. Ten years experience in Nursing in which 3 years as Deputy Nursing Superintendent and 7 years as Assistant Nursing Superintendent.

6. Post of Nurses in the Office of the Directorate of Health Services and Dts.G.H.S., i.e. Assistant Director of health Services (Nursing)/ Dy Director (Nursing) Superintendent of Nursing Services for any such designation.

Essential qualification:-

1. Master's degree in Nursing.
2. Ten years experience of which 8 years in Nursing Administration.
3. Registered Nurses and Registered Midwife.

Relaxation:- In experience for candidates belonging to Scheduled Casts/Scheduled Tribes for all categories of positions in the Nursing profession.

2. District Public Health Nursing Officer.	<u>Essential qualifications:</u> 1. Post-Certificate Diploma in Public Health Nursing and supervision Post-Basic B.Sc. Degree Or B.Sc. Degree in Nursing. 2. Registered Nurse & Registered Midwife. 3. Five years experience of working as a Public Health Nurse of which years in Public Health Nursing Administration as P.H.C. level.  <u>Desirable:</u> Master's Degree in Nursing.
3. Female Health Worker.	1. Matriculation or 10 <sup>th</sup> Pass. 2. Registered Auxiliary Nurse-Midwife. Or 8 <sup>th</sup> Pass candidates who have done 2 years A. N. M. Course and Registered as A. N. M.
4. Female Health Supervisor.	1. Matriculation or its equivalent. 2. Registered Lady Health Visitor Or A. N. M. who have done 6 months promotional course with 5 years experience as an A. N. M.

N. B.:- In case she is a qualified Lady Health Visitors or does not apply.
