State of the World's Nursing (SOWN) 2025 report provides the most comphresive and up-to-date analysis of the nursing workforce of the world. The report features new indicators on critical area for nursing, such as education capacity, advance practising nursing and remuneration. There are five additional policy priorites and the compliation of data from each WHO region. The report provides up-to-date valid data and evidence on the global nursing work force, as reported through standardized approach improves data availiability. It further says a Unique Nurse Identifier (UNI) system can be helpful in health workforce planning and management by tracking nurse licensure, specialization and deployment across regions.
