Inaugural celebration of Commemoration of 150 years of National Song “Vande Mataram” on 7th November 2025- reg.

The National song Vande Mataram was written by Bankimchandra Chatterjee during the auspicious occasion of Akshya Navami which was on 7th November in 1875

The song, invoking the Motherland as the embodiment of strength, prosperity and divinity, gave poetic expression to India's awakening spirit of unity and self-respect. It became an enduring symbol of devotion to the nation.

Since Independence, Vande Mataram has continued to hold a place of special honour in official ceremonies, public events and educational institutions, representing the ideals of patriotism, unity and service to the nation. In recognition of its historic importance and national significance, the Union Cabinet, chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, on 1st October 2025 approved the nationwide celebrations to mark 150 years of the national song, Vande Mataram. The Inaugural Event regarding Celebration of Commemoration of 150 Years of National Song "Vande Mataram" is scheduled on 7th November 2025.

All Nursing Colleges/ Schools to organize Mass Singing of “Vande Mataram” (full song) at their respective Colleges/ Schools premises at 10:00AM on 7th November 2025, in conjunction with the Inaugural Ceremony wherein Mass singing will be done in presence of Hon'ble Prime Minister. All nursing students and faculty of College/ School of Nursing to view the live telecast of the Hon'ble Prime Minister's address (scheduled at 10.35 AM) during the Inaugural Programme

Principals of all Colleges/ Schools of nursing will arrange for activities mentioned in para 7 to 10 of the enclosed letter no. 42-21/6/2025-AKAM received from Ministry of Culture (C & M Section) dated 04.11.2025 (copy attached) through the campaign website <https://vandemataram150.in/>

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Inaugural Celebration of Commemoration of 150 Years of National Song "Vande Mataram" on 7th November 2025.

The undersigned is directed to convey that the Inaugural Event regarding Celebration of **Commemoration of 150 Years of National Song "Vande Mataram"** is scheduled on 7th November 2025, wherein all Union Ministries/Departments and their subordinate/attached offices are requested to actively participate on this occasion.

2. The National song Vande Mataram was written by Bankimchandra Chatterjee during the auspicious occasion of Akshya Navami which was on 7th November in 1875. Vande Mataram first appeared in the literary journal Bangadarshan as part of his novel Anandamath in a serialised manner and later as a standalone book in 1882. During that period, India was undergoing major social, cultural and political changes, and there was a growing consciousness of national identity and resistance to colonial rule. The song, invoking the Motherland as the embodiment of strength, prosperity and divinity, gave poetic expression to India's awakening spirit of unity and self-respect. It soon became an enduring symbol of devotion to the nation.
3. The popularity of Vande Mataram grew rapidly in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. On 24th January 1950, while announcing the adoption of the Constitution, Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the First President of independent India and also as President of the Constituent Assembly, stated that the song Vande Mataram, which had played a historic part in the struggle for India's freedom, shall be honoured equally with Jana Gana Mana and have equal status with it. Since Independence, Vande Mataram has continued to hold a place of special honour in official ceremonies, public events and educational institutions, representing the ideals of patriotism, unity and service to the nation.
4. In recognition of its historic importance and national significance, the Union Cabinet, chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, on 1st October 2025 approved the nationwide celebrations to mark 150 years of the national song, Vande Mataram.

5. In this regard, a year-long commemoration from **7th November 2025 to 7th November 2026** has been approved by the National Implementation Committee on 24th October 2025.

6. The Ministry of Culture will be organizing the **Inaugural Ceremony** of the commemoration on **7th November 2025** at **Indira Gandhi Indoor Stadium, New Delhi**. The programme will serve as the formal launch of the commemoration and is expected to be graced by **Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi as Chief Guest**. The event is scheduled to commence at **10:00 AM**.

7. Accordingly, Followings are requested from all Union Ministries/Departments and their subordinate/attached offices, as under:

a. **To organize Mass Singing of "Vande Mataram" (full song) at their respective office premises at 10:00AM on 7th November 2025, in conjunction with the Inaugural Ceremony wherein Mass singing will be done in presence of Hon'ble Prime Minister.**

b. It is requested that the **live telecast of the Hon'ble Prime Minister's address** (scheduled at 10.35 AM) during the Inaugural Programme may also be arranged for viewing in the respective offices.

c. During the program, address of Hon'ble Ministers, Secretaries may be organized on the importance and contribution of National Song 'Vande Mataram' (*copy enclosed as annexure*).

8. Further, the approved branding collaterals (hoarding, banners, website banner, etc.) along with short film and exhibition on Vande Mataram, audio with lyrics on Vande Mataram (full version) will be available on the campaign portal <https://vandemataram150.in/>.

9. The digital activation campaign this year is Karaoke with Vande Mataram. This will enable users to record Vande Mataram in their own voice and upload on campaign website (<https://vandemataram150.in/>). All citizens are encouraged to participate in this national campaign.

10. Details of all events being done by the Ministry and Department may be uploaded on the campaign website(<https://vandemataram150.in/>) with special mention of participation of people in numbers.
