Nursing faculty with M.Sc (N), order of preference:

M.Sc in Obstetrics & Gynecology Nursing/Community Health Nursing/Pediatric Nursing/Child Health Nursing who have successfully completed the virtual capacity building program of 6 days module (attach certificate).

Certification: Certificate of completion with **25 CNE credit hours** will be provided to participants who successfully complete the training.

Age Limit: **Less than 57 years.**

Training fee: **Rs. 20,995** /- (includes training fee, boarding and lodging, **excluding travel**)
Training fee is **sponsored** by INC for **two faculty** from an institution/self.
More faculties from an institution can be sponsored by their own institution.

Cancellation: Participants who are sponsored by Indian Nursing Council shall not cancel their participation after booking the tickets otherwise they shall be liable to pay the cost of cancellation of tickets to Indian Nursing Council.
