Subject: Strict monitoring of Anti-Ragging measures as per INC guidelines & UGC guidelines -reg

In continuation of the **INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN NURSING COLLEGES**, 2016 Gazette notified by the Indian Nursing Council available on INC website <https://indiannursingcouncil.org>
→<https://indiannursingcouncil.org/uploads/pdf/16455350476527052646214df470fd98.pdf> regarding prevention of ragging in Nursing Institutions, it has come to the notice of the Council that incidents relating to ragging, student harassment, mental stress and student suicides have been reported in various educational institutions across the country. Such incidents adversely affect the academic environment, student well-being and professional development of Nursing students.

In this regard, it is reiterated that all Nursing Institutions are required to ensure strict compliance with the anti-ragging provisions and maintain a safe, secure and conducive learning environment for students. Further, all Institutions shall strictly adhere to the anti-ragging regulations/guidelines issued by University Grants Commission from time to time and ensure compliance with all prescribed requirements, including but not limited to:

1. Constitution and functioning of Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad.
2. Display of anti-ragging provisions, helpline numbers and contact details at prominent places in the institution and hostels.
3. Submission of Anti-Ragging undertakings by students and parents, wherever applicable.
4. Conduct of awareness and sensitization programmes for students, faculty and staff.
5. Establishment of an effective grievance redressal mechanism and prompt action on complaints.
6. Ensuring a safe and supportive environment in classrooms, clinical areas, hostels and associated facilities.

The Head of the Institution shall be personally responsible for ensuring compliance of anti-ragging measures and for taking immediate preventive and corrective action in accordance with applicable rules/regulations.
